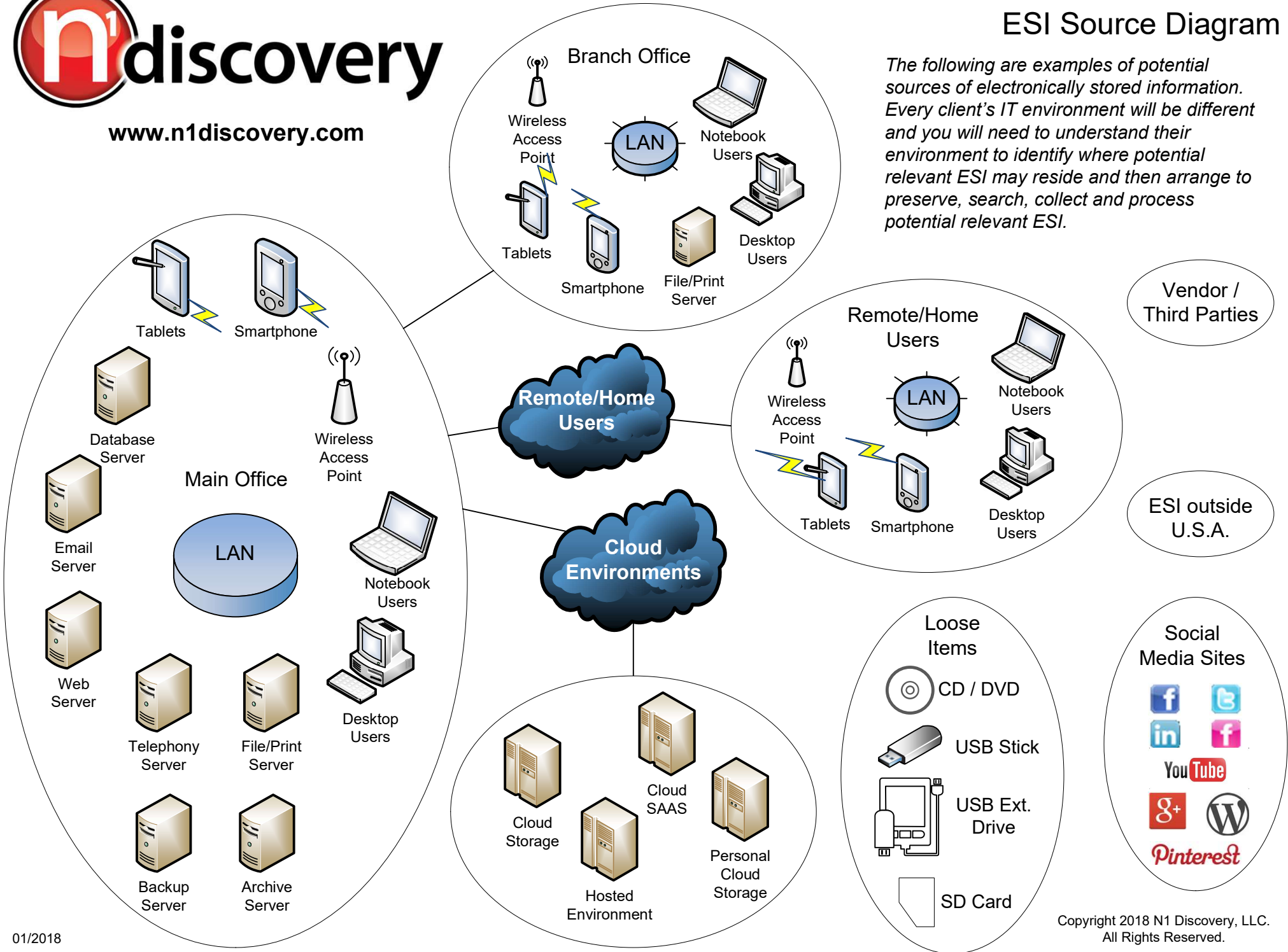


# ESI Source Diagram
